

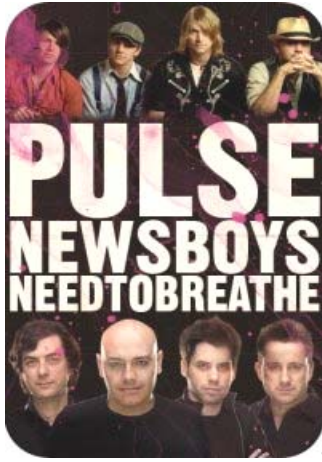

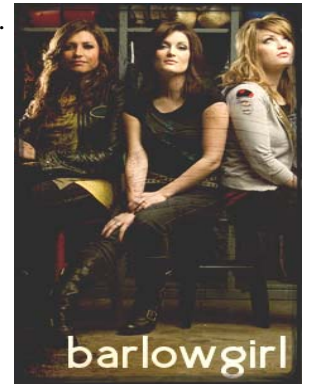
The Biggest Outreach To MSU Ever!
