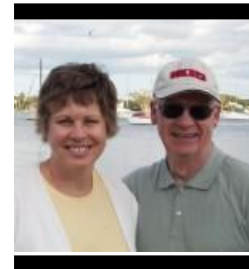

Operation Christmas Child

1 **SHOE BOX**
Use an empty shoe box (standard size, please) or a small plastic container. You can wrap the box (lid separately), but wrapping is not required.

Pray for the child who will receive your gift.

2 **BOY OR GIRL?**
Determine whether your gift will be for a boy or a girl, and the child's age category; 2-4, 5-9, or 10-14. Use the appropriate boy/girl label and mark the correct age category on the label, tape the label to the top of your box.

3 **FILL WITH GIFTS**
Fill the box with a variety of gifts that will bring delight to a child.

4 **INCLUDE YOUR DONATION**
Please donate \$7 or more for each shoe box you prepare to help cover shipping and other project costs. You can give online, or you can write a check to Samaritan's Purse (note "OCC" on memo line) and place it in an envelope on top of the gift items inside your box. 5 **DROP OFF**
Place a rubber band around each shoe box and lid and drop your box off at the table in the fellowship Hall. (Deadline will be announced.)

Gift Ideas:

Toys

Small cars, balls, dolls, stuffed animals, yo-yos, jump ropes, toys that light up or make noise (with extra batteries), etc.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

Pens, pencils and sharpener, crayons or markers, stamps and ink pad sets writing pads or paper, solar calculators, coloring and picture books, etc.

HYGIENE ITEMS

Toothbrush, toothpaste, mild bar soap (in a plastic bag), comb, washcloth, etc.

OTHER

Hard candy and lollipops (please double bag all candy), mints, gum, T-shirts, socks ball caps; sunglasses, hair clips, toy jewelry, watches flashlights with extra batteries)

A PERSONAL NOTE

In a separate envelope, you may enclose a note to the child and a photo of yourself or your family. (If you include your name and address, the child may write back.)

DO NOT INCLUDE:

Used or damaged items; war-related items such as toy guns, knives or military figures; chocolate or food; liquids or lotions; medications or vitamins; breakable items such as snowglobes or glass containers; aerosol cans

Recycling

Did you know that you can take your empty cans directly to the Recycling Center and still help the Youth Group? If you ask the Recycling Center to donate your tokens to Trinity Church, they will send us the paper tokens which can be redeemed at MarketPlace Foods. The Youth Group uses the tokens to help purchase soda for the soda machine in the kitchen. Proceeds from the soda machine go towards Kelvin's support, the boy they sponsor through Compassion International.



The Recycling Center buys sorted recyclables, including: aluminum cans, newspaper, magazines, hard covered books, soft covered books, junk mail, office paper, steel/tin (tin food cans, metal jar lids, handles from 5 quart pails, empty paint cans, aerosol cans), and cardboard (corrugated boxes, paper grocery bags).
